Dear Praying Friends,

We recently received a note informing us that Jewish people are coming to faith and cited as an example a Rabbi who had a vision of "the virgin Mary" and converted to Catholicism. From the tone of the note it appears that the one sending it was convinced that this was a sign that Jewish people are now flocking to belief in Jesus. While this Rabbi may have converted to Catholicism, there is no evidence that he came to faith in Jesus as Messiah. As I travel across this country preaching in churches I have found there is an alarming misunderstanding as to what salvation truly is. It seems that just as Rabbinic Judaism has changed Biblical Judaism from the necessity of the shedding of innocent blood, a substitutionary death to mere liturgy and good works, so it seems churches are changing biblical salvation to mere adherence to a religious experience. Biblical salvation is not complying with a religious system, nor is it reacting to some religious experience even if it produces a change in lifestyle. Biblical salvation requires we acknowledge our sin and that the sacrifice of Messiah on the cross, the shedding of His innocent blood, His death and resurrection is the only means by which our sins can be cleansed and our soul saved. True biblical salvation requires we open our heart and receive Jesus as our Savior. Simply joining a church in no way satisfies this. In the times in which we live, it is imperative that we return to a commitment to this very important biblical truth! 1 Corinthians 14:8 "For if the trumpet give an uncertain sound, who shall prepare himself to the battle?"

Our outreach continues to move forward. We stay busy here locally with our direct outreach into the local Jewish community as well as our extended outreach now in Houston, Austin and San Antonio through our tract outreach. We have now sent our tract to 169,000 Jewish families. Every week, in every church in which I preach, more and more are people volunteering to address envelopes and provide postage. So many of these volunteers pray for these Jewish families who were on their list by name every week Please join us in praying weekly for these Jewish families.

Michele has had her cataract surgery now in both eyes and is recovering very well. Michele has always needed a prism in her glasses to deal with an astigmatism in her left eye. When the surgeon removed the cataract in her left eye, he also removed this astigmatism which caused the healing to take a little longer. She is seeing better than ever now.
