than 3600 decisions.

Just this month while preaching in Florida, a lady came to me following the service to let me know her friend had trusted the Lord as her Savior that night. She told me that in the midst of my message her friend leaned over and told her that she did not think she was saved and couldn't wait for the invitation. The interesting thing is that I was not preaching an evangelistic message but one on consecration.

I am working on the outreach project I spoke of in my last prayer letter. I am almost finished writing the tract which deals with prophecies of Messiah fulfilled by Jesus. I believe it will provoke a response and open doors to witness among the Jewish people here in the Metroplex. Once finished I will need to have it laid out by a graphic artist and then printed. We have been told of a printer who may do this for us quite economically; then we will mail them to Jewish people, starting in Ft. Worth and moving across the Metroplex from there. Two important things to note: First, it is important these be as attractive as possible or they will not be read; and secondly, these cannot be mailed by bulk mail as that will render them as "junk mail" and simply be thrown away without looking at them.

As such, the cost will be greater than if we simply ran them off on our copy machine and then bulk mailed them. I should have the cost estimate for you by my next prayer letter and by that time can let you see the raw text of the tract. In the mean time, Michele and I are praying you will be willing to help us with the cost of this outreach project. I plan to mail 1,000 each time and expect the follow up on the response I will receive to keep me very busy. Once that settles down I will send out another mailing. I am excited about this and trust you will be part of making this happen.

Michele and I remain grateful for your faithful prayer and financial support. Apart from you our ministry could not be possible. Please never forget that it is by your mercy that they
