Dear Praying Friends,

I began traveling again in February and was fortunate to preach in churches here in the Metroplex, Houston and Georgia. It was so good to be back in the pulpit again. I witnessed the Lord move the hearts of those in each church as I transferred my burden to their hearts.

Our outreach in the Jewish community continues to move forward. We recently had several return the response card that we send with the tract expressing a desire to learn more. We are in the process of following up on these. We are currently sending the tract to Jewish families in Austin and San Antonio. It seems we found a pocket of Jewish people in some Campbellite churches. I started receiving notes from some taking issue with me regarding faith and repentance. This particular man told me he wanted me to defend these positions using Greek definitions. I then received a packet of material published by the Church of Christ with a note that he had read my pamphlet so it was only fair that I read his material. He sent me 5 or 6 items totaling more than 100 pages. It seemed a little imbalanced and I honestly had no desire to spend my time reading what I knew to be unbiblical...so I just tossed them and haven't responded. Useless debates are not the wisest use of one's time. We must be on our guard not to allow the Devil to draw us away from our service of Messiah into things that will prevent us from pursuing our goal of taking the gospel to Jewish people.

I have a niece who needs your prayers. Lisa is 49 years old, she and her husband both love the Lord and are faithful in their service to Him. Last Saturday she and Mike were out when Lisa began to show signs of what Mike thought was a stroke. He took her to the ER where they did an MRI and then rushed her into surgery. She had 3 tumors on her brain. They quickly removed two but the third was very deep and took hours to remove. The lab work came back showing Lisa has stage 4 metastatic melanoma. The oncologist said they caught it very early and it is treatable. I looked this up to find that this is when the melanoma presents itself far from the initial site such as the liver or brain. When this happens, it is always called stage 4, but does not mean it is automatically fatal. Right now, Lisa is in physical therapy for the next 2 weeks. The doctors are well pleased with her progress thus far and will determine when to proceed with radiation and/or chemo. Lisa has a long road ahead but they are strong in their faith. Please keep Lisa, Mike and their 4 children in your prayers as they travel this journey together.

Michele and I remain grateful for your prayer and financial support. Apart from you, our ministry could not be possible. Please always remember, it is by your mercy they shall obtain mercy. Romans 11:30-31.
