Dear Praying Friends,

The antisemitism which is raging across our country and in many places across the world is growing, not merely in its numbers but in its apparent acceptability. Make no mistake that before people join in openly displaying antisemitism or they can demand our country join in their antisemitism, it first must be deemed an acceptable mindset. As abhorrent as this is, there is a hidden aspect upon which this is having a strong impact. Jewish people, in the face of such strong antisemitism quite naturally close ranks as a form of self-preservation. In so doing, my people stand more strongly against the evangelistic effort of believers in the Jewish community. We see this in those whose reaction to the tract we mail them is to say the least extreme. One such man sent us a letter with big bold red letters demanded that we delete him from our mailing list. He went on to threaten that if we ever mail him anything else he will consider it harassment and will file a lawsuit against us. At the bottom he handwrote "STOP IT!" Obviously, this is a very extreme reaction but it is fueled by the antisemitism he and the Jewish community is experiencing. Knowing that my people consider any attempt to evangelize them as antisemitic activity it becomes easier to understand why they would react in such a manner, especially as they experience such a huge uptick of this hatred for Jewish people across our country with no accountability. There is no question all of us must fervently pray for Jewish people but also for those of us at risk for just wanting to speak with them about their Messiah.

Our tract outreach continues to move forward. Believers in every church I am in keep signing up to address envelopes with a burden for providing this gospel witness to Jewish people. To date we have mailed my tract to 185,000 Jewish families. This could not be possible apart from all those in the churches who volunteer to be part of this effort. We appreciate all of you more than you can possibly know!
