Dear Praying Friends,

I was recently in Orlando, FL doing a Christ in the Passover and spoke of how my father taught me about God and Messiah through such things as the Passover. His teaching actually helped me become a believer...though he never understood or believed that Jesus is Messiah. The Pastor told me that a teenage girl got saved after the service. Her Dad was not a believer and held contempt for everything associated with the Lord. For over a year she had been coming to church and her father made it very difficult for her every time she went. He stood in her way of accepting Jesus. That night she told the Pastor, "If he (meaning me) could handle his dad then I can handle mine!" She then accepted the Lord as her Savior!

It always amazes me how God uses my story to bring others to faith. This is why I speak so freely of my father, how he never believed, how he stood in my way of ever hearing the name of Jesus much less a gospel witness, and how he sat Shiva, grieved me as dead and never spoke to me again. It is never for sympathy but to give others freedom to break from that fear and get saved! It's such a blessing that God uses my story in this way!

Our local outreach continues to move forward. We have now mailed our tract to 138,000 Jewish homes which represents some 600,000 Jewish people. We have now sent this tract to every Jewish family in the Dallas/Ft Worth Metroplex. Now the work begins as we seek to work with those who respond to this tract and develop a witness opportunity. We are now focusing on Houston, where there is a very large Jewish community. Please continue to keep this outreach in prayer!

We are still dealing with the aftermath of all the water damage from those pipes that burst due to the freeze we had last month. ServPro has finished tearing everything out and treating everything to prevent mold from growing. They found much more damage than they first anticipated. The insulation and sheetrock had to be replaced. The painting should be done late next week and then the flooring contractor can begin to replace all the flooring. It seems the cost just keeps increasing every day. Apparently, Allstate has a different idea of what it means to cover the cost of repairs and are using a cost basis that was outdated 20 years ago. At this point it looks like we will be left with a substantial amount they cover. They are coming in about \$12,000 less than the actual cost of restoring our home. We are thankful for 2 pastors who saw this coming and sent us a check to help before I even knew I'd need it. We now need to raise roughly \$10,000 to finish all this work. We would be more than grateful for any help in offsetting this need.

Michele and I remain grateful for your continued prayer and financial support. Without you our ministry could never be possible. Always remember, it is by your mercy that they shall obtain mercy! Rom 11:30-31.
