Dear Praying Friends,

I recently preached a Purim Service and only after the service I found out there was a Jewish lady present. She stayed for the time of fellowship and told her friend that had brought her that she wanted to speak with me. She told me she was raised Orthodox but today considered herself secular. She then she said this was the very first "Messianic" service she had ever attended and really did enjoy it. As we talked I gained the very strong sense that I should temper my statements and just sought to draw her in a bit at this point. She told me that she understood the difference being that Jewish people do not accept Jesus as Messiah while Messianics do. That opened the door for me to give her some of my personal testimony, which she appreciated. She said she was open and I encouraged her to read my tract and to come back to hear the Pastor which she agreed to do. Later I found that in past conversations she had told her friend that there was a pastor who would come to "supposedly" help her with some work around her house only to use that as an opportunity to try to "jam" his beliefs down her throat and she was sick of it. I guess this is where I was getting that sense to tread softly with her. Her friend called me a few days later and I gave her some direction on how to best deal with her. Please keep this lady in your prayers that she will keep seeking and that she will ultimately come to faith.

Our 2023 Israel Tour is now closed. We are just 6 weeks from our departure date and have another excellent group. I'm expecting another wonderful tour! Every church I preach in I always encourage the church to send their Pastor and his wife. I explain that the impact this will have on his study and preaching of the Word of God will come through the pulpit every time he stands before them. Every year I have 2 or 3 churches take up on this...this year I have 8 churches who have sent their Pastors! That is a first!

I am already taking Deposits for our 2024 Tour. We already have a good number so I would encourage you to make your deposit as soon as possible! The dates are May 20-30, 2024. Please email me with any questions.

Our tract outreach continues to move forward. To date we have sent this to a total of 163,000 Jewish families. Please remember that the real work begins once we receive a response. It is typically a long and involved process and tends to be time consuming. Since we do not have a defined Jewish community here the tract is designed to get my people to come to us. Michele deals with any ladies who respond and I deal with the men. Please continue to pray for this effort and for those receiving the tract, whether they respond or not, if they read it then I know it will have an impact!
