November was a very blessed and a very trying month. When my flight arrives home Michele will wait for me outside the airport parking. My flight can be delayed or it can often take a very long for the bags to be delivered to the baggage claim. Rather than pay parking charges she waits at the DFW office area where there is plenty of free parking. When I text her that I have my bags, she will come to pick me up. On this occasion, when I told her I had my bags she sent a text back that the battery had died and she was stuck. I had Uber pick me up, stop and pick up Michele and take us home. We then hopped in our car and drove back to the airport and called for a tow truck. 90 minutes later they arrived and towed the Tahoe to the dealership. The battery was under warranty, but I had to pay for the tow.

Two weeks later when my flight arrived at DFW and Michele came to pick me up, as she pulled up Whammo! The right rear tire blew out! And I mean 5 places in the side wall of the tire! It looked like someone shot the tire 5 times. I hit the OnStar button and they sent someone to change the tire and 90 minutes later we were on our way. The tire was under a road hazard warranty that I purchased when I bought the Tahoe so there was no charge to replace the tire. The following week I told Michele not to blow up the Tahoe when she came to get me and she told me it would not be a problem! She said she was never picking me up again, I would have to take Uber from now on!

Both were very unusual situations and both were covered by warranty, and both instances happened right at the airport for which I am thankful! These could have happened while Michele was on the freeway and could have proven very dangerous for her. I am grateful that the Lord was watching out for Michele in both situations and kept her safe and sound!
