Dear Praying Friends,

I am quite certain you, like everyone, have been keeping a close eye on the war in Israel. Hamas, emboldened and financed by Iran is on a mission to eliminate the world of not only the State of Israel, but all Jewish people. Israel, under the very strong leadership of Benjamin Netanyahu is now determined more than ever to rid the world of Hamas. Once they started their ground incursion, they have been moving methodically and quickly and as I write this have Gaza City surrounded on 3 sides. If the world will stay out of this and leave Israel alone, she will meet her goal and the world will be a safer place for all of us.

Please know that Israel is at war with Hamas and not the Palestinians. Israel has always treated the Palestinian people very well.
