Sundown Sunday, September 9 launched the 22 day period known as the High Holy Days. It begins with Rosh Hashana which is the Feast of Trumpets, commonly known as the Jewish New Year. The common greeting on Rosh Hashana is Shanah Tovah which means "A Good Year." When I woke up the morning of the 10th I received a text from a Pastor letting me know that the night before his church had voted to take us on for monthly support. I explained to him that they had made that decision on Rosh Hashana and that I could not have hoped to begin the new year in a better way. He had truly made it "A Good Year"! I am praying that this will be just the first of many to follow this year!

Much of September was spent in Texas preaching in Amarillo, Granbury, Beaumont and Channelview, then on to Albuquerque and Michigan. I was in 7 churches, 5 of which were new churches for us. In each church we saw the Lord do a wonderful work in the hearts of the people and I am convinced they left with a burden for a people group so often left out and neglected in their missionary and evangelistic outreach.

Our outreach here in the Metroplex continues to grow, we have now mailed my What Will Messiah Look Like tract to 85,000 Jewish people. That is more exciting than I can express! Please keep these Jewish people in your prayers. Once they have read this the Holy Spirit can use it to convict their hearts and draw them to faith. Please do not stop praying!
