Dear Praying Friends,

I had an interesting conversation this month with a Jewish man who received our tract. He contacted me wanting to talk and I had no idea what to expect. It turns out he had recently accepted Jesus as his Messiah and knows he is now saved, but still has some difficulties he still to overcome. These will be dealt with as he grows and to that end I will be connecting him with a pastor in his area who can help him. He told me that while he fully believed he needed to Jesus to save his soul, he did not believe Jesus was the one and only way because his parents, who were wonderful people, had already passed and they never accepted Jesus as their Savior. He told me he could not believe that Jesus was the only way as that would mean his parents were in Hell. So, while Jesus was his way to Heaven his parents must have found another way. This is a very difficult hurdle which often prevents Jewish people from accepting Jesus. I made an attempt to steer his thinking but in a limited phone conversation all I was able to was point him to some scripture and give him things to consider. This is why I am happy to know some men in his area who can meet with him on a regular basis and help him to grow both in his faith and his understanding.

I have decided to once again move our dates for our Israel tour. I need a minimum of 20 people to make the tour work and despite so many sincere promises I came short. Despite the hostilities being over people are still hesitant about making this trip. They very much want to go but are still dealing with fear generated by the rhetoric that fills the news. I have spoken with my guide and my guy at the tour company in Jerusalem and have decided to move the dates to June 14-24, 2027. Thankfully most who signed up for this year are willing to roll over to next year so I will not be starting from zero which should make it easier to fill the tour.
